Located in the heart of Paris (*Quartier Latin*), Paris-Panthéon-Assas University is the first and oldest Law University in France. It has developed a leading reputation in France and abroad for the quality of its teaching and research and stands out for a distinguished history, a solid foundation and an innovative atmosphere.


Devoted to provide students with first-rate education, it instructs nearly 23,000 students, in all areas of the Law, Political Science, Economics, Management, Information and Communication Science.

Since January 1, 2022, Paris-Panthéon-Assas University has been an experimental public institution built on a novel integrative model. With its four component institutions (EFREI, ISIT, CFJ and École W) and its partner institute (IRSEM), it is establishing itself as a new player in higher education and research in the legal sciences, with a stated ambition: to accompany and support the legal transformations of society in France, Europe and the world, and to participate in a better dissemination of law in society.

Its professors are unanimously recognized as highly qualified specialists in their fields of expertise both in France and abroad.

Our University aims to develop exchanges with partners in Europe and at the international level that share the vision of aiming high-standard quality in education and research programmes.


The university's academic offerings include undergraduate and postgraduate degrees, ranging from LL.B. to PhD programmes.




Key figures

Research at the University/ PhD programmes

Paris-Panthéon-Assas University counts:

- 5 doctoral schools, including 4 in Law
- 26 research centers with over 300 lecturer-researchers
- Nearly 1,000 PhD candidates, 83% of them are in Law and Political Science
- 100 theses defended each year A research budget of more than 20 Million€ per

Foreign students can also pursue their PhD thesis under joint supervision with a supervisor in a partner University.





International outlook

Paris-Panthéon-Assas University values its partnerships and international relations.

More than 20 professors are in charge of more than 300 cooperation agreements with almost 200 partner universities at a European and an international level.

The University has a Vice-President in charge of international affairs as well as a dedicated department which manage collaborations and student exchange programmes within the framework of cooperation agreements. Furthermore, the department also assists individual foreign students.

4EU+ Alliance




EUROPEAN UNIVERSITY ALLIANCE Paris-Panthéon-Assas University is a member of the European

University Alliance 4EU+. Panthéon-Assas University is renowned for its excellence in social sciences, and law in particular. It therefore complements the profile of the other members (Charles University in Prague, Heidelberg University, Sorbonne University in Paris, the University of Copenhagen, the University of Geneva, the University of Milan, and the University of Warsaw) and participates in strengthening the multidisciplinary nature of 4EU+.

For Paris-Panthéon-Assas University, this will also be an opportunity to further invest in multi-disciplinary research within a European academic system, particularly on issues such as sustainable development and artificial intelligence.

Events and festivities are offered (free of charge) by the University in order to help incoming students adapt to their new studying environment and the Parisian lifestyle:

- Introductory courses and seminars in French Law
- French language courses
- Sports welcome meeting, a great way of getting to know other students of the University
- Welcome events by the Erasmus Student Network association (ESN).



Exchange programmes

The University offers many exchange programmes with some of the most prestigious universities in Europe and around the world.

The University proposes a most extensive offer and variety of courses to partner incoming students. In Law for example, incoming students may choose courses amongst any of the first four years of studies. Most of these programmes are organized under the Erasmus+ framework: out of the 850 exchange students per year, 60% are Erasmus+ students.





Dual degrees and integrated curricula

The University counts 9 dual degrees in Law (French and partner country's Law) with high quality partner universities in the United Kingdom, Germany, Spain, Ireland, Switzerland and Italy.

Paris-Panthéon-Assas University has also created a Master degree, the *Juriste européen* within the European Law School network that counts 8 European universities. Students must complete their Master's programme within 2 of the partner universities:

- King's College London
- Humboldt University in Berlin
- Amsterdam University
- La Sapienza University of Rome
- Autonoma University of Madrid
- Kapodistrian University of Athens
- Catolica University of Lisbon

The University has also established 9 specific selective partnerships of Integrated curricula during which students spend a full-time year abroad.

Programmes taught in French specifically designed for international students

Diplômes supérieurs d'université (DSU) 6 specialized Master-level university degrees in Law: an excellent way of preparation, for students with a B2 French language, to apply for a Master national degree the year after:

- Business and Corporate Law
- International Private Law
- International Public Law
- Administrative Law
- Civil Law
- European Union Law

Master's degree in French and European Law (possible to recruit students with a C1 French-language level within the framework of a specific agreement) LL.M. in French, European and international Business Law (C1 French-language level required).


Paris-Panthéon-Assas University offers degrees based entirely abroad in Asia and Hungary:




Libraries

Sports

International students are welcome to attend the University's annual Job Fair: an opportunity to meet French, European and International Companies and Law Firms.
